HOW THE FAA REAUTHORIZATION AFFECTS VPOS

The FAA Reauthorization has finally passed and been signed into law by President Biden on May 16, 2024.

The Bill contains provisions in sections 830 and 831 that cover fuel reimbursement and



enhanced safety requirements by Volunteer Pilot Organizations.
